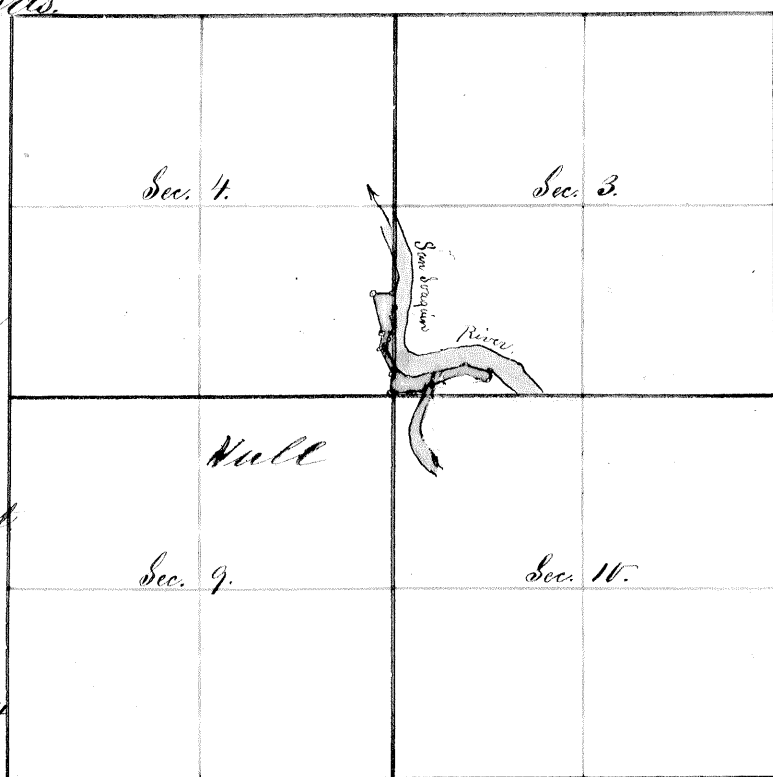

Field Notes.

Beginning at the corner of Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10. Township 7 South
Range 9 East of Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, thence along the United States
Meander Line, the same being the Meander Line of the "Crestima Rancho", up stream
N. $89\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.10 chains, N. $63\frac{1}{4}$ E. 11.00 chs, N. $69\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.54 chs, to a Post, set at intersection with
the North and South line between the East $\frac{1}{2}$ and West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3,
from which a Willow tree, 12 inches in diameter, bears S. $22\frac{1}{4}$ W. 2.48 chs, distant, thence
N. $7\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.21 chs, to the left bank of the San Joaquin river, thence down stream, N. $70\frac{1}{2}$
4.50 chs, S. 76 W. 13.10 chs, N. $56\frac{3}{4}$ W. 3.26 chs, N. $34\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.50 chs, N. $12\frac{1}{4}$ W. 2.25 chs, N. $21\frac{1}{4}$ E. 1.90 ch, N. $47\frac{1}{2}$
1.50 chs, N. 39 E. 1.50 chs, N. $5\frac{3}{4}$ W. 1.16 chs, N. $19\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.50 chs, N. $36\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.20 chs, N. $1\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.50 chs, to inter-
section with the East and West line between the North $\frac{1}{2}$ and South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec.
Thence S. $89\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.01 chs, to a Post set at intersection with said U.S. Meander line, from which
a Willow tree 18 inches in diameter bears S. 56 E. 1.93 chs. dist, thence along said Line up stream
S. 15 E. 8.56 chs, S. $4\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.00 chs, S. $22\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6.00 chs, S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.33 chs, to the point of beginning.
